By-laws (excerpts)

ARTICLE I

Section I. This Council shall be known as MONSIGNOR PAUL DEGNAN COUNCIL NO. 2603, Knights of Columbus.

Section 2. The initiation fee shall be \$30.00 except for applicants under 26 years of age it shall not exceed \$10.00 and for priests and religious it shall be nil.

ARTICLE IX – Miscellaneous

Section I. These By-Laws may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting at a council meeting held subsequent to a council meeting a which a resolution in writing providing for such amendment shall have been read and notice of the proposed amendment shall have been given to the members in writing or in the council publication at least five days prior to the second meeting.

Section 2. Procedure and debate shall be in accordance with the Laws and Rules of the Supreme Council, the Supreme Board of Directors, these By-Laws and the Rules of Parliamentary Law known as "Robert's Rules of Order."
